What We Do

New Horizons' Social Security Specialists credentialed as Work Incentive Practitioners and Community Partner Work Incentive Counselors, work with counselors from the Michigan Department of Career Development/Rehabilitations Services (MDCD/RS) to provide assistance to individuals currently receiving SSI or SSDI benefits who desire to obtain employment.
