What We Do

New Horizons' Social Security Specialists credentialed as Work Incentive Practitioners and Community Partner Work Incentive Counselors, work with counselors from the Michigan Department of Career Development/ Rehabilitations Services (MDCD/RS) to provide assistance to individuals currently receiving SSI or SSDI benefits who desire to obtain employment. Here's what we can do:

- Address all pertinent issues regarding SSI and SSDI benefits
- Provide an informational packet to better understand your benefits, including a resource guide for future planning
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- Provide advocacy regarding SSI & SSDI issues
- Assist in writing PASS plans
- · Assist with reporting work and wages
- Advocates with overpayment
